#### SUGGESTIONS FOR PARISH OR DEANERY EVANGELISATION TEAMS

Here follows a plan, with timings, for an evangelisation meeting, that can help parishes begin to grow missionary disciples. Beginning with prayer, and then sharing, members can feedback where God may have been calling them to share the Gospel in their own lives since the last meeting – this may help you to discern what God is doing in the parish. There can then be a combination of formation and planning/evaluation. This may change depending on how busy the group is, but care should be taken not to forget regular formation: the aim is to practise missionary discipleship. Finally, there is some time to pray specifically for the work of mission and for particular events or initiatives.

Different parishes have held meetings weekly, fortnightly and monthly:

# MEETING OVERVIEW (Approx. 1hr30m-2hrs)


- OPENING PRAYER (5m)
- EVANGELISATION SHARING (15m) Sharing personal opportunities you've had to evangelise, arising between meetings.

...then a combination of... (up to 1hr)

- EVANGELISATION FORMATION Periodic catechesis on evangelisation over a number of weeks.
- PLANNING & EVALUATION
   Of evangelisation work as needed.

...then... (up to 30m)

PRAYER FOR EVANGELISATION
 Essential prayer for the work of mission – for both individuals & parish.
