## GUILD OF ST. STEPHEN SILVER MEDAL OF MERIT APPROVAL FORM

Silver Medals of Merit can be awarded with the approval of the Diocesan Director, on the recommendation of the Parish Priest or Guild Chaplain. They are awarded in recognition of the faithful and special service given by servers who have:

- Been serving at least 20 years, (but not necessarily all that time as enrolled as members of the Guild)
- Have given faithful service throughout that period (not necessarily in the same parish.)

The medal awarded is either silver-plated or solid silver. It is designed to be worn on the cotta or alb, in a similar fashion to a military-style medal. **Please do not send any remittance until the award has been approved. You will then be invoice when the medal is supplied.**
