Silver Medals of Merit can be awarded with the approval of the Diocesan Director, on the recommendation of the Parish Priest or Guild Chaplain. They are awarded in recognition of the faithful and special service given by servers who have:

- Been serving at least 20 years (but not necessarily all of that time as a member of the Guild).
- Have given faithful service throughout that period (not necessarily in the same parish.)

Note: A brief resume of their service should be provided on the reverse of this form by the Parish Priest or Guild Chaplain.
